PROTECT 2020-ILLINOIS CYBER NAVIGATOR PROGRAM

Election infrastructure has become a focal point for foreign cyberattacks. The US Department of Homeland Security (DHS) designated the United States election systems as critical infrastructure for the country on January 6, 2017. In March 2018, the federal government appropriated \$380 million in grants to all states and territories to assist in improving election security. In response, the General

Assembly tasked the Illinois State Board of Elections with creating a cybersecurity program to help every Election Authority improve their cybersecurity posture. In 2018, the Illinois legislature passed Public Act 100-587 (specifically 10 ILCS 5/1A-55) and the State Board established the Cyber Navigator Program through Administrative Rule. (Title 26, Chapter 1, Part 213)

This presentation will dissect each of the three components of the program; outreach, infrastructure and personnel. What attendees will learn? We will discuss creating partnerships with other agencies to create a more robust overall structure for all county officials. We will discuss the support the regionally assigned Cyber Navigators can provide to each county and we will also supply a sample of the regional trainings election officials participated in during the summer of 2019. Participants can expect to see firsthand the types of improvements the 108 election officials have made as we prepare for the 2020 election cycle. We will also discuss the areas in which we still need to work to improve the cyber security posture overall.


